DEAR PARENT,

THE SEAFORD PUBLIC LIBRARY IS PARTICIPATING IN A STATEWIDE READING PROGRAM, "MAKE A SPLASH - READ". THIS PROGRAM, DESIGNED TO ENCOURAGE THE ENJOYMENT OF READING, WILL BEGIN MONDAY, JUNE 28TH AND CONTINUE UNTIL TUESDAY, AUGUST 17TH. KEEPING THE READING HABIT ALIVE OVER THE SUMMER IS IMPORTANT!

RECENT RESEARCH INDICATES THAT CHILDREN LOSE AS MUCH AS FOUR MONTHS PROGRESS IN READING SKILLS DURING SUMMER VACATIONS. CHILDREN WHO PARTICIPATE IN A SUMMER READING CLUB PROGRAM SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASE VOCABULARY SCORES ON STANDARD TESTS ADMINISTERED IN SEPTEMBER. YOUR HELP IS NEEDED TO MAKE THE PROGRAM SUCCESSFUL.

FIRST OF ALL, READ. SEEING PARENTS READ IS ONE OF THE MOST POWERFUL EXAMPLES A CHILD CAN HAVE. SHOWING THAT READING IS AN IMPORTANT SOURCE OF INFORMATION AND PLEASURE INCREASES THE CHANCES THAT YOUR CHILD WILL ALSO VIEW READING THAT WAY.

READ TO YOUR CHILD. JUST A FEW MINUTES SPENT EACH DAY SHARING A STORY OR PART OF A BOOK CAN INCREASE INTEREST IN READING. BEDTIME IS OFTEN A GOOD TIME TO SHARE THE LOVE OF READING. DON'T STOP READING TO YOUR SCHOOL-AGE CHILD. HE OR SHE MAY STILL ENJOY BEING READ TO AND MAY ALSO ENJOY READING TO YOU.

VISIT THE LIBRARY OFTEN, AND LET YOUR CHILD DISCOVER THE ADVENTURE AND FUN OF CHOOSING BOOKS FROM THE LIBRARY'S COLLECTION. PROVIDE BOOKS THAT YOUR CHILD ENJOYS. FIND BOOKS THAT RELATE TO YOUR CHILD'S INTERESTS AND READING ABILITY. MAKE READING A RELAXED AND PLEASANT ACTIVITY. DON'T FORCE YOUR CHILD TO READ FOR LONG PERIODS OF TIME. READING FOR FIFTEEN MINUTES EACH DAY HELPS A CHILD KEEP READING SKILLS SHARP.

FINALLY, ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO JOIN THE SUMMER READING CLUB PROGRAM, "MAKE A SPLASH - READ" AND SHARE THE FUN OF THE VARIOUS ACTIVITIES PLANNED. THANK YOU FOR BEING OUR PARTNER IN HELPING YOUR CHILD BECOME A LIFELONG LOVER OF BOOKS AND READING.

ACHIEVEMENT CERTIFICATES WILL BE PRESENTED TO THOSE WHO HAVE REPORTED ON 7 BOOKS.







AT THE SEAFORD HARBOR SCHOOL @ 10AM.


