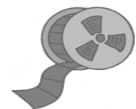

## NUHEALTH MAMMOGRAPHY VAN

Thursday, July 14<sup>th</sup> 8:45am-12:00pm

NuHealth, in conjunction with Senator Michael Venditto, is hosting a mammography van in the Library parking lot. The program is open to all Nassau County women ages 40 and over. Women who are covered by insurance, Medicaid or Medicare will have their carrier billed and must bring their information card to the screening, along with a prescription from their physician. NuHealth's policy requires patients to be responsible for any copays charged by their carrier. Women ages 50 and older without health insurance will be eligible to be enrolled in a grant program which covers the costs of the screening at no out-of-pocket cost to the patient. **Please contact the Senator's office at (516) 882-0630 to schedule your mammogram.**

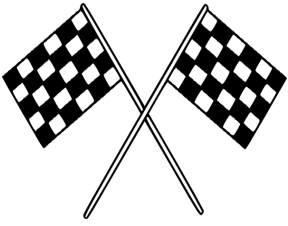
