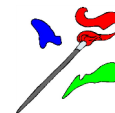
ESCAPE THE LIBRARY

Monday, July 16th 5:00-6:00pm



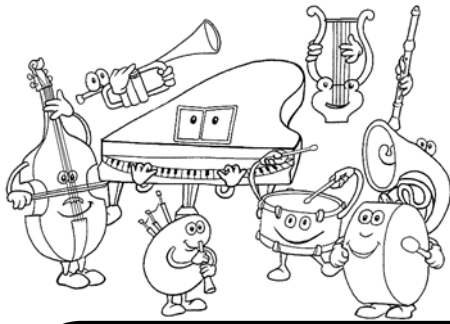

Teen Summer Reading Program

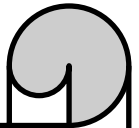
