The Library has been closely monitoring the recommendations from the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) and the New York State and Nassau County Health Departments.

The Library has been taking the following precautions:

- Cleaning the building extra thoroughly throughout the day and evening
- Sanitizing door handles, handrails and elevator buttons
- Cleaning keyboards, mice and table tops
- Providing cleaning wipes and hand sanitizers throughout the building

- **RBdigital Magazines** - download and read magazines online using your computer, tablet, or smart device.
- **Kanopy** - stream videos online using your computer, tablet, or smart device.
- **Online Databases** - conduct research.

As per the CDC, we are recommending:

- Patrons who are ill refrain from visiting the library.
- Cough into the bend of your arm or in a tissue. Please throw out used tissues in the available trash receptacles.
- Wash your hands often (for at least 20 seconds).
- Limit physical touching.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
